- e) The syllabus prepares and motivates to pursue higher education/research.



- The syllabus prepared and motivated 82% of them to pursue higher education /research.









The Syllabus has good balance between theory and application




- Most of the teachers (99%) agreed to the statement that the syllabus is suitable to the programme, need based, updated and good balance between theory and application

- The syllabus has prospects for competitive exams/ higher education/ employability in the perspective 98% of the faculties





- Around 85% of the alumni have agreed on the programme and facilities of the college










- None of the employers disagrees with the fact that course content has enough scope of the development of analytical, logical, technical and creative skills to the students.





- Only 4% of the parents disagrees with the fact that the syllabus prepares and motivates to pursue higher education/research









