GRIEVANCE REDRESSAL POLICY

OBJECTIVES

The main objective of the GRC-TKMMC is to ensure an approachable and responsible attitude among the staff towards the students to uphold harmony on the campus. In this context the objectives of the GRC-TKMMC are:

- To develop a step by step structure to resolve grievances of students
- To support students unjustly deprived of the services offered by the College, rightfully theirs
- To ensure that the staff of the College are responsive, accountable and courteous in dealing with the students.
- To provide quick and effective resolution of student's grievances in an nondiscriminatory and just manner.

GRIEVANCE REDRESSAL MECHANISM

A systematic mechanism for the redressal of students' grievances is functioning in the college. If the student has any grievance on non-academic issues, she/he may approach the Teacher in-charge/ Department Head. If it doesn't get resolved there, the matter may be reported to the Principal who refers it to the grievance redressal cell, constituted as follows:

- Senior faculty
- Staff secretary
- Staff representative
- HODs concerned
- Woman representative
- Student representative

The cell looks into the grievance and makes its recommendations to the Principal In order to address the grievances regarding academic matters, a four-level redressal mechanism is envisaged. Complaints regarding evaluation shall be brought to the notice of the teacher concerned. If the student is not satisfied with his/her decision, he/she may appeal to the Departmental Redressal Cell, which consists of the HOD, the teacher-in-charge for that class and the teacher against whom the complaint is

made as members. The student shall also have the freedom to make a further appeal to the College Level Grievance Redressal Cell, which consists of the Principal, Controller of Internal Examinations and the HOD concerned as members. Complaints can be filed online at https://www.tkmmc.ac.in/grievance.php If the student is not satisfied, he/she may appeal to the University Level Grievance Redressal Cell. The verdict of the University Level Redressal Cell shall be final.
