A nature camp was organized from TKMM College, Nangiarkulangara from 26.9.2016 to 28.102016 to **Periyar Tiger reserve (PTR)**, **Thekkady**. The participants were NSS volunteers of Degree second year (6 boys and 15 girls) from different departments.



The team started at 10 AM from College and reached destination by 3.30 PM. We had our packed Lunch at Mundakkayam. Convenient Dormitories were given to us and healthy vegetarian food was supplied by the Forest authorities. There were introductory classes on PTR on the first day evening. The refreshingly cool weather and early morning bath in the chill unpolluted waters thrilled and rejuvenated all of us. The second day ie. 27.10.2016 was scheduled for forest trekking. Two experienced forest guards accompanied and guided us. Many rare and interesting forest trees like 'Maravuri', Chandanam, Strangler fig, 'Chorakkaali', 'Marotti', 'Kula maavu', wild kariveetti (Rose wood), 'Arani' (tree logs used by ancient saints to spark fire) could be seen. Lush greenery by 'Maruthu' trees (Lagerstroemia) occupied majority of the forest canopy.

































### 2. '<u>My Tree Programme'</u>


