REPORT OF REGULAR ACTIVITIES 2020-2021

An Overview

The Covid-19has resulted in the sudden shift of NSS activities from normal to the digital platforms. Across the world the people have been told to stay home, the NSS Unit of TKMM College, Nangiarkulangara organized several online activities to cope with the new situation of Corona virus epidemic. They stayed home, recommended measures of social distancing and isolation. The volunteers used social media to create public awareness to fight against Covid19. Unit has undertaken programmes in responsive to Covid19, to specially reduce the stress and to make the best productive result of their time. Many initiatives were taken to serve the community.

. Volunteers registered as **Covid brigadier**. Time was used for **tree planting and extensive vegetable cultivation**. Volunteers got the best opportunity to attend multifaceted programmes. **Blood donor's directory** was prepared to encourage blood donation during Covid time. **Palliative and other charity** works were conducted. Students made a **'no plastic campaign'**. Steps were taken to **conduct Covid survey**, joined hands with authorities in handling Covid Pandemic and in the conduct of general election. Conducted many Covid drives to create awareness and also helped the public to register for vaccination. Volunteers also conducted **water survey**.

Volunteers attended many Integrated Govt. Online Training courses and campaigns on Covid 19 which enabled them to handle things easily and efficiently. As

the volunteers are remaining in their home, they got the best time to pursue the newareas of knowledge.

Unit conducted more awareness programmes than previous years, most often the volunteers and webinars, days' observation by themselves, Steps were taken to increase the appetite for **reading among students** and to rediscover the magic of Books.Two literary pursuits have been produced by the NSS Unit during this year-One is the online flip magazine 'Sugatham', the camp magazine released in commemorative to the great poetess Sugathakumari'. The Second one is the book 'SMS'- a work based on the survey study of 100 houses by the volunteers during lock down days. The work really gave an insight to the conditions of the people, their financial strains, mental stress etc. We took initiative to help the palliative patients, and cancer distorted ones under Karuthal and Sparsam project respectively.


NSS PO Preetha MV was in charge of the camp.7 days virtual camp HOPE 2020


The Cultural Night was fantastically done by all Groups in all days with different names like.

All the volunteers shared their experiences of virtual camp in the function.



In the valedictory session volunteers presented the best of their cultural programmes.




