Action Plan:


- To form a group of quiz enthusiasts.


Reading Day Celebration










IN ASSOCIATION WITH DEPARTMENT OF CHEMISTRY









READING DAY CELEBRATION IN ASSOCIATION WITH DEPARTMENT OF MATHEMATICS


"Poetry Is The Rhythmical Creation Of Beauty In Words"


